**Designed to move safely and easily around curved and complicated turns, our Sarum stairlift is compact, comfortable and convenient for awkward stairs.**

#### **The chair**

You can choose to have push-button or joystick controls on either arm helping you to move up and down the stairs in comfort. The swivel seat which turns to face the landing makes getting off at the top of the stairs safe and trouble-free. When not in use, the arms, seat and footrest fold away, keeping the stairs and hallway clear for other users.

#### **The rail**

Our curved stairlifts are tailor-made to fit your individual staircase and ensure the best fit possible. The twin rails are available in a pearl colour as standard, with an additional five colour options.

Our rails are fitted to the stairs, not to the wall and installation is quick and clean, meaning minimum fuss and disruption in your home.

#### **New and reconditioned models**

Our Sarum chairs are available to buy as either new or reconditioned models.

All pre-used stairlifts are reconditioned and rigorously tested by our team of engineers using a 42 point check, before being fitted in your home.

#### **Our rental scheme**

You can also rent our Sarum stairlifts which allows you to enjoy the benefits of a new or reconditioned Stannah whilst paying for the stairlift one month at a time. We will take care of the servicing for you and remove it when you no longer need it.

#### **The service**

The reliability of our stairlifts comes from the quality of the engineering and design. For your added peace of mind, all our new and reconditioned products are backed up by a full warranty and service package. Just like any piece of machinery, we recommend that your stairlift is serviced annually by a trained engineer. We will arrange with you to come and visit to give the stairlift a thorough and complete service, putting it through its paces.

You won't have to wait for service or help as our nationwide teams of engineers are locally-based. They are on standby 24-hours a day, 365 days a year to respond quickly in the unlikely event that you might need assistance.

### Self-charging battery

The Sarum always has the optimum amount of power so you get a smooth ride with a gentle start and stop. It even works if there is a power cut.




### Swivel seat

Using the levers enables you to swivel the seat easily, making it simple to get off the chair. Alternatively, you can choose to have a powered swivel seat, which turns the chair to face the landing automatically.



### Footrest lever

To store the stairlift away, you can fold away the arm and seat and press the lever to raise the footrest. There's no awkward bending down, which is particularly useful at the top of the stairs.



### Safety edges

If there is something blocking the chair on the stairs, the safety edges recognise this and the lift will stop automatically.



### Wall control

You can use the wall controls to call the stairlift for yourself or send it to someone else.

### Upholstery material

You can choose from a range of colours to suit the look of your home.



### Directional controls

Right-handed or left-handed, we can put the controls on either arm. We can fit push-button or joystick controls, whichever you prefer.



### Keyswitch

Occasionally you might need to immobilise the stairlift. If children are around for example, you can use this key to make sure it can't be used.



### Retractable seatbelt

Fasten the seatbelt for added security.



### Curved rails

Fitted to the stairs and not to the wall, the twin curved rails are available in a pearl colour as standard with a additional five colour options.





1. Using the Sarum is simple and easy. To unfold it, pull down the seat and arms and use the lever to lower the footrest.

2. Once unfolded, make yourself comfortable in the seat. Fasten the seatbelt for extra security.

3. By pressing gently on the controls in the direction you wish to go, you can travel up and down the stairs.



4. Once at the top of the stairs, you can swivel the seat to face the landing, allowing you to get off the chair in complete safety.

5. If you wish, you can leave the chair in its swivelled position, creating an effective barrier.

6. When you are not using the stairlift, it can be folded away so that it takes up less space and leaves the stairs clear for other users.
